

Stationery List Grade 1

1. 1 box of crayons (**16/24 count, no glitter crayons**)
2. 6 pencils (sharpened)
3. 2 glue sticks (to be replaced periodically)
4. 1 pair of safety scissors
5. 1 highlighter
6. 1 container of disinfecting wipes
7. 1 roll of paper towels and 1 box of tissues

We will purchase all other supplies needed (folders, pencil boxes, copybooks, etc.). You will be charged a fee for these items when your child begins school. It will be required that **all books be covered with clear contact paper**. It is **strongly** suggested that you purchase this contact paper now because it is difficult to find once the school year begins.

The summer reading assignment for incoming first graders is **If You Give a Mouse a Cookie** by Laura Numeroff. This book is available for purchase at Barnes & Noble. Your child can read this book, with your help, over and over again. He/she should draw a picture of their favorite part and bring the book and the picture to school on the first day.

We recommend that you continue to reinforce number and letter (upper and lower case) recognition and initial consonant sounds. Your child should know the following:

1. **His/her full name, address and telephone number**
2. **How to print his/her full name (first and last)**
3. **How to zipper, button, tie shoes and buckle a belt**

Please have your child wear a tag with his/her bus number or car line written on it daily for the first week of school. This will help avoid any confusion for the children at dismissal.
