Neumann Scholars Program

The Neumann Scholars Program, honoring the founder of parochial schools, St. John Neumann, the fourth bishop of Philadelphia, is an initiative sponsored by the Connelly Foundation. Developed in 1994 to promote and reward academic excellence among students in parish/regional schools, the program provides scholarships in each district of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia to those who excel in an independently administered test. Students designated as Neumann Scholars are offered four year scholarships to any of the seventeen Archdiocesan High Schools. Each year the Neumann Scholarship is equal to the standard parental tuition. Eighth grade students must meet criteria set by the Connelly Foundation and are then invited to sit for the Neumann Scholars Test in January. The following Holy Family Regional Catholic School students have met the criteria and have received invitations.
